At the end of the eleventh century, Saint Hugues de Semur, abbot of Cluny, built the current large church, known as one of the masterpieces of Romanesque art. In 1875, Pope Pius IX elevated this church to the rank of Basilica. dedicated to the Sacred Heart.

# Paray-le-Monial, city of the Heart of Jesus

She entered the Monastery of the Visitation of Paray-le-Monial in 1671. From 1673 to 1675, Christ appeared to her several times and revealed to her his « divine Heart passionate with love for all men ». She was given the mission of spreading

the message and devotion to the Heart of Jesus that would make Paray-le-Monial famous throughout the world: « This is

As a young Jesuit, Claude la Colombière was sent to Paray-le-Monial where he authenticated the spiritual experience of Marguerite-Marie. After a brief stay in England, he fell ill and returned to Paray-le-Monial where he died at the age of 41. Canonized in 1992 by John Paul II, he is the "apostle of trust."

In 1985, the activities of the Sanctuary was entrusted to the Emmanuel Community by the Bishop of Autun.

On October 5, 1986, the visit of St. John Paul II gave a new impetus.

Every year, tens of thousands of people from all over the world find in the Heart of Jesus the meaning of their lives and a new hope.


